

Council Cleanups

Greater Taree City Council and Great Lakes Council both conduct a kerbside collection service for the removal of “approved” bulky items too large to be placed inside your wheelie bin.

This will now be an annual service. During the collection period, residents can place bulky mixed solid waste and metal items in **two separate piles** on the kerbside for collection. The maximum size of each pile is limited to two cubic metres & mixed piles will not be removed.

Following are the scheduled dates for collection during 2010:



Great Lakes Council - February 8th to February 19th.



Greater Taree City Council - June 7th to July 2nd.

Specific dates for each zone within both Council's areas will be notified as the collection time draws nearer.

Items not acceptable include:

- Organics - no green waste items are acceptable;
- No material suitable for placement in the resident's MGBs;
- Trade, industrial and shop wastes. This includes items such as plumbing fixtures, water tanks, tiling (both floor and wall);
- Building and Demolition materials, concrete and bricks;
- Panes of glass;
- Household hazardous wastes such as paints, asbestos sheeting, solvents, chemicals, cleaners and unwanted medicines;
- Lengths of material longer than 1.8 metres (excluding mattresses, lounge suites etc);
- Material which cannot be reasonably removed by two (2) persons;
- Chemicals or hazardous wastes;
- Soil and stones;
- Fuels or oils;
- Liquids or paint;
- Tyres, Heavy Motor Parts, Car Batteries;
- Food scraps and household garbage.
