

GREAT LAKES COUNCIL – BULKY WASTE CLEAN UP

23 May to 1 July 2011

Midcoast Waste along with Great Lakes Council is providing a Kerbside Bulky Waste Clean Up for all residences currently receiving a waste and recycling collection service.

Great Lakes Council is also trailing the collection of reusable items in Forster, Tuncurry, Nahiab, Green Point & Pacific Palms. Reuse items collected will be on sale at the Tuncurry Waste Management Facility Tip Shop. The reuse truck will collect reuse items **ahead** of the bulky waste collection truck.

Please put your bulky waste out the **weekend prior** to the schedule below:

23 to 27 May	All of Forster
30 May to 3 June	All of Tuncurry
6 to 10 June	Green Point, Pacific Palms, Coomba Park and Smiths Lake including all household in this area normally receiving waste services on Tuesdays each week.
13 to 17 June	Failford, Nahiab, Wootton, Seal Rocks, Bungwahl and all households in this area with Wednesday waste services. Also Bulahdelah and all households in this area receiving a Monday waste service.
20 to 24 June	Nerong to Karuah, Pindimar, Tea Gardens and Hawks Nest including all households in this area receiving waste services Monday to Thursday.
27 June to 1 July	The Bucketts Way, Booral Rd, Stroud and Wards River including all households in this area with Friday waste services.

Please place your bulky waste neatly next to the edge of the kerb and not blocking the footpath at your normal weekly collection point. It is also important to place your reuse items, metals and bulky waste items in three separate piles. Please secure all items to avoid windblown littering.

The volume of bulky waste collected from any one property shall not exceed two (2) cubic metres or more than 1 standard (6'x4') level box trailer. Items must be able to be handled by two people and not exceed 30kg.

Rural residents who have a common collection point for their weekly waste collection should place their bulky items at the same location.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: Bulky waste includes larger items of household waste.

- Household appliances and whitegoods (all doors **must** be removed)
- Household furniture, painted wooden products and fittings
- Mattresses
- Pottery, ceramics and chinaware
- Metal waste (sorted separately and tins must be empty of any liquid)
- Other bulky household items
- Loose items must be tied securely with rope or string (not wire) into bundles or contained in sturdy boxes (not in plastic bags).

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS: These materials will NOT be collected

- Trade, industrial and shop wastes. This includes items such as plumbing fixtures, water tanks, tiling.
- Wrecked motor vehicles, motor vehicle parts, engines and tyres
- Building and demolition materials, concrete, bricks & panes of glass
- Household hazardous wastes such as paint, asbestos, solvents, chemicals, cleaners and unwanted medicines
- Lengths of material longer than 1.8 metres (excluding mattresses & lounges)
- Batteries

- Liquids of any sort including Fuels and Oils
- Recyclables collected in your yellow lidded bin.
- Garden organics timber, grass clippings etc.
- Soil and stones
- Material suitable for placement in your red lid bin service including food scraps and household garbage.

The Contractor and Council have the right to reject any material they consider unacceptable.
