

# Recovery of Your Old Bins

Further to the introduction of the new bin system, the recovery and recycling of all old bins has been scheduled.

A few general points are:

- ♦ Old bins are to be placed out **completely empty** - they cannot be removed if they contain any items!
- ♦ They are to be placed out **upside down**, with the lid in the open position.
- ♦ If they are not collected on the day, please **leave them out** and they will be removed as soon as possible.
- ♦ The contractor will go down each street only **once**. If you miss putting your bin out, it can be taken to one of the landfill depots listed below.

For residents in the **Greater Taree City Council** area, removal of old bins will commence on November 9th.

Please place your old bins out for removal on the **same** day your new yellow bin is put out for servicing. For residents on Week B, this will be from November 9<sup>th</sup> through to the 13<sup>th</sup>.



Week A residents should put their old bins out from the 16<sup>th</sup> through to the 20<sup>th</sup>.

In the **Great Lakes Council** area, again please place your old bins out on the **same** day your new yellow bin is put out for servicing. For residents on Week B, this will be from November 23<sup>rd</sup> through to the 27<sup>th</sup>.



Week A residents should put their old bins out from November 30<sup>th</sup> through to December 4<sup>th</sup>.

The contractor has also agreed to take any old unwanted green waste bins as long as they are also upside down and empty.

And please remember if you miss the contractor, bins can be delivered to the following local landfills at no charge:

- Greater Taree City Council - The Bucketts Way, Tinonee.
- Great Lakes Council - Tuncurry, Tea Gardens, Bulahdelah or Stroud.
